






ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH


1. RIMC PREPARATION 2021

The preparatory classes for RIMC aspirants continued through the month of July to provide orientation, guidance, learning and practice to prepare the boys to appear in the exam and qualify for selection in the Rashtriya Indian Military College. Entrance exam which was originally scheduled on 5th June is now scheduled for 28th August 2021. The teachers taught topics according to the syllabus. They clarified doubts and taught techniques to do quick and easy calculation in Mathematics. Subjects such as General Knowledge, Current Affairs and Logical Thinking were addressed through available books and online reference.



2. SAINIK SCHOOL COACHING
