





## v. AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV


### i. INDIA'S INVENTIONS AND DISCOVERIES




### ii. INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

International Mother Language Day was observed by the students of classes VI-VIII on 21st February to promote awareness of linguistic and cultural diversity and to promote multilingualism.




## vi. EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT

## vii. SCIENCE OLYMPIAD FOUNDATION CLASSES




### **viii. AWAKENED CITIZENS PROGRAM**

### **ix. ART AND CRAFT CLUB**




## **xi. SPORTS HOBBY CLASSES**


## **xii. CODING CLASS**
